

# IASN Quality Program Overview

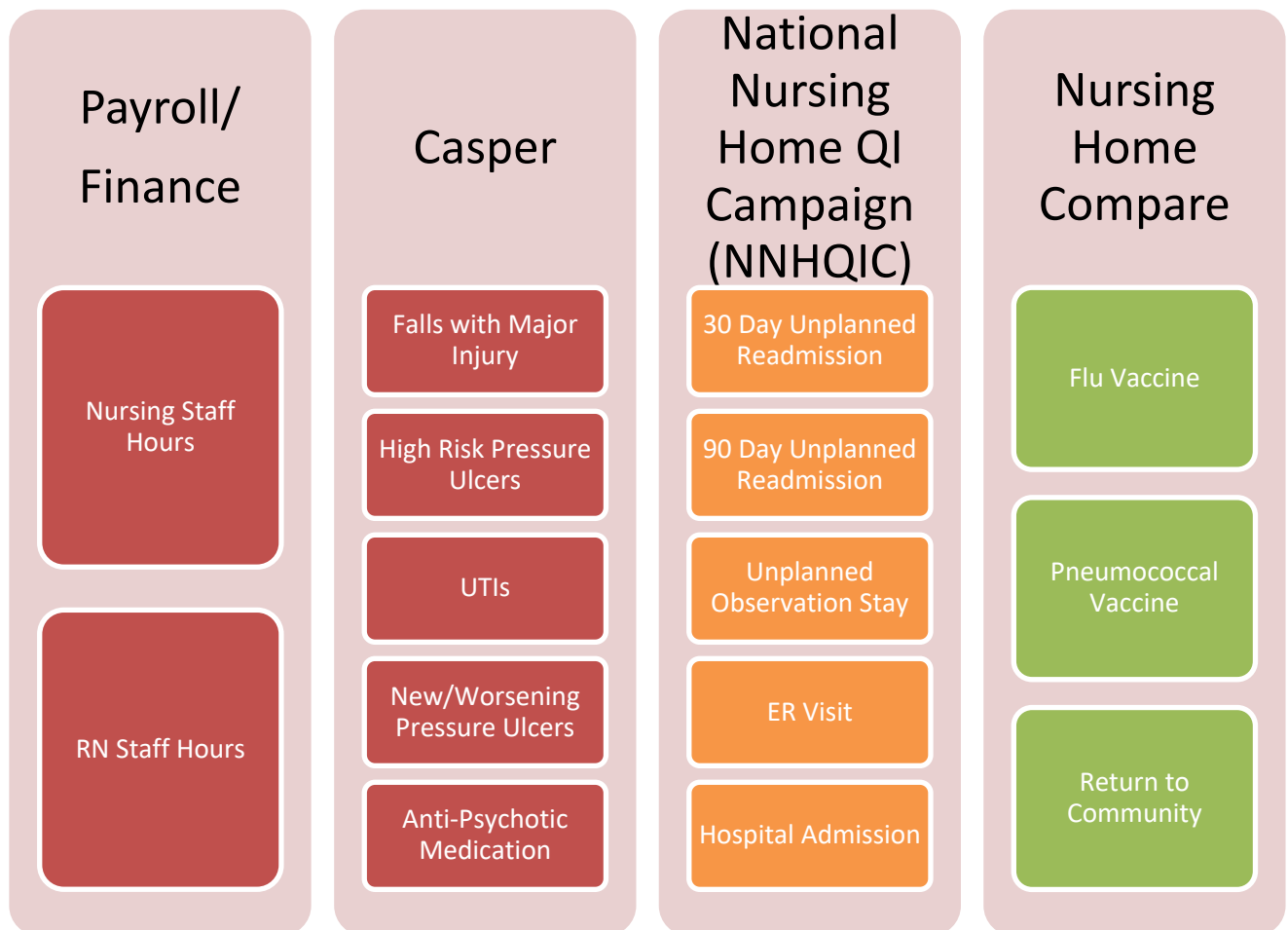
The Iowa Aging Services Network (IASN) was created to drive quality practices, outcomes and payments.

## Creating the Quality Standards

In building a Quality Program, many factors were considered, including the key measures that payors care most about, those that will lead to value based contracts, and those that demonstrate quality. Also considered were ways to reduce the administrative burden and effort, as well as ability of members to comply with the quality program. There is no one tool or metric that compiles all of these key considerations. The Iowa Health Services Network (IASN) Quality Program was developed to bring together the most relevant, and efficient, ways of demonstrating quality to payors. IASN is a leader in compiling, stratifying and presenting this quality information into a quality dashboard.

## Quality Measures

Below are all the quality measures and sources for each measure recommended by the IASN Quality Committee and approved by the IASN Board:



- Data entry in cPMT required
- Use NNHQIC, no duplicating entry if signed data use agreement
- No data entry required
